8. At the end of each week, Mike receives \$10 as an allowance. Jodi receives \$4 less than Mike, and Jim receives \$2 more than Jodi. What is Jim's allowance?

9. Leia starts with 9 beads. She gives 3 beads to Paul. Then Leia buys 5 new beads. Which statement below is true?  
 (A) Leia has the same number of beads now as when she started.  
 (B) Leia has fewer beads now than when she started.  
 (C) Leia has 2 more beads now than when she started.  
 (D) Leia has 5 more beads now than when she started.
  
10. Monica lives 3 blocks west of Lisa. Lisa lives 2 blocks west of the library. Jim lives 4 blocks west of Monica. How many blocks does Jim live from the library?  
 (A) 1      (B) 9      (C) 3      (D) 6
