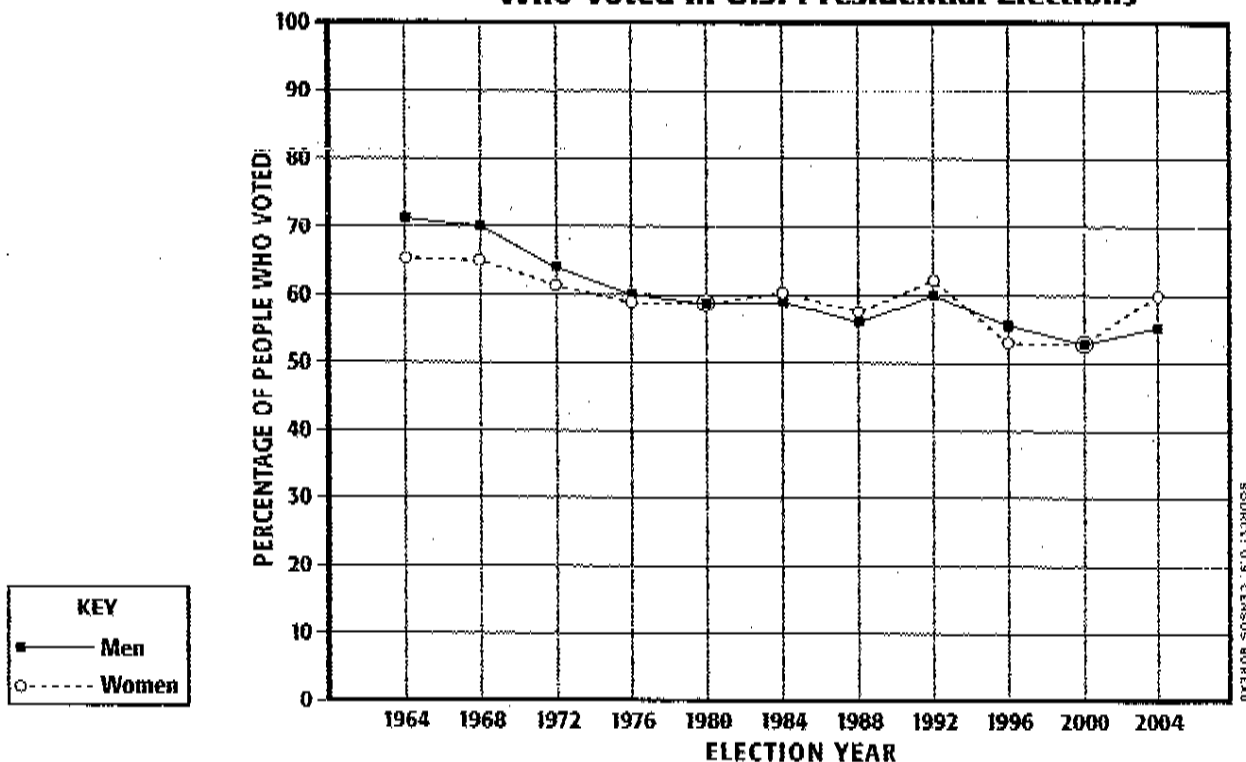


# Voter Turnout

A **double line graph** displays two sets of data over time. The **key** shows what information each line represents.

The double line graph below shows what percentage of women and what percentage of men voted in the last 11 presidential elections. Read the graph, then answer the questions.
