

Going for Gold

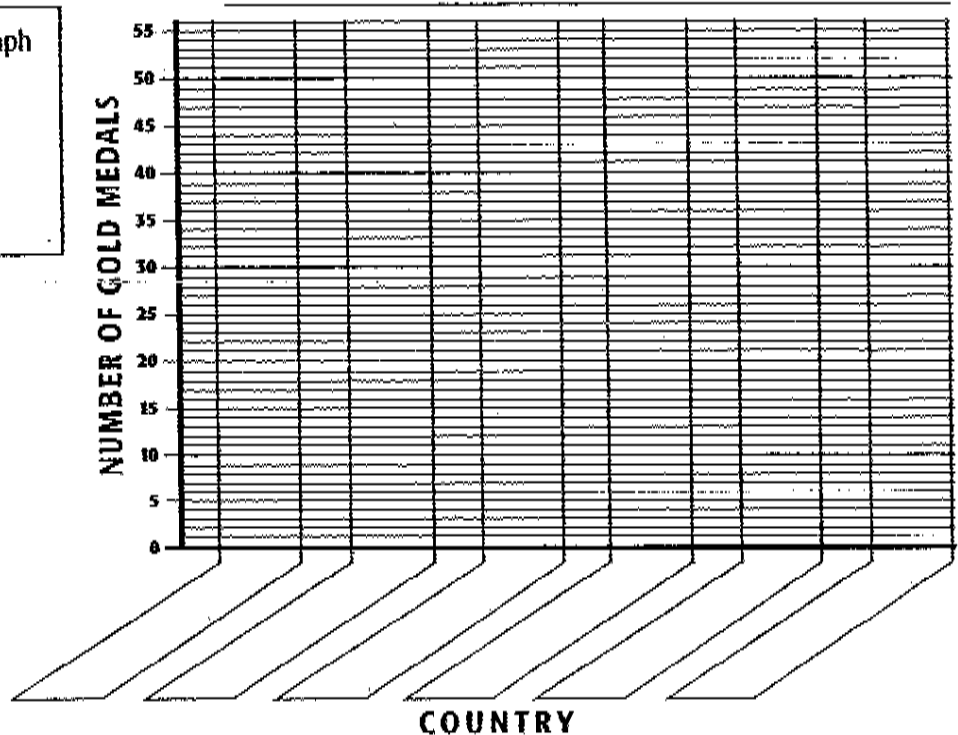
Follow the steps to build a bar graph that shows the top gold-medal-winning countries from the 2008 Olympic Games. Then answer the questions below.
